According to the ACCME Standards of Commercial Support, a **conflict of interest** is present when individuals (or their spouses/partners) are in a position to control the content of CME have a relevant personal financial relationship (i.e. speaker honoraria, consultant fees, contracted research, stock/shareholder, etc.) with a commercial interest* that benefits the individual and may ultimately bias the content of CME activities to learners. A potential conflict of interest may exist if there is (1) a relevant financial relationship (in any amount) with a commercial interest occurring within the past 12 months, and (2) the opportunity to influence the content of CME concerning the products or services of that commercial interest.

**Per the ACCME, a commercial interest is any entity producing, marketing, re-selling, or distributing health care goods or services consumed by, or used on, patients.*

The Medical University of South Carolina recommends that each physician fully review all the available data on new products or procedures prior to instituting them with patients.
